OLDER ADULTS

Older adults (age 65 and older) as a percent of the total population, in North Dakota's districts:

5.4% to 25.9%



OLDER ADULTS LIVING ALONE


Households with older adults (age 65 and older) living alone as a percent of total households, in North Dakota's districts:

2.5% to 17.3%

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Median household income in North Dakota's districts:

\$31,939 to \$104,456



BELOW 200% OF POVERTY


Percentage of people below 200 percent of poverty level, in North Dakota's districts:

8.2% to 53.6%

HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN

Households with children (under 18 age old) as a percent of total households, in North Dakota's districts:

11.5% to 43.1%



DISABILITY

People, of all ages, living with a form of disability, as a percent of the total civilian noninstitutionalized population, in North Dakota's districts:

6.3% to 17.2%

NO HEALTH INSURANCE

People ages 0 to 64, with no health insurance coverage, as a percent of the civilian noninstitutionalized population ages 0 to 64, in North Dakota's districts:

3.5% to 27.9%
